Guests who purchase a Colonial Williamsburg adult Annual Pass online Nov. 23-26 can purchase a second at 50 percent off for a saving of more than \$33. This offer is available at specials.colonialwilliamsburg.com.

The Colonial Williamsburg adult Annual Pass provides admission to Historic Area sites, trade shops and certain daily programs, plus the DeWitt Wallace Decorative Art Museum and the Abby Aldrich Rockefeller Folk Art Museum. Pass holder benefits include 25 percent off most evening program tickets and child costume rentals and 10 percent off Colonial Williamsburg store and food and beverage purchases and tickets to Busch Gardens Williamsburg and Water Country USA. Passes purchased through the promotion are valid through Dec. 9, 2019.

#GivingTuesday PayPal Match

Revenue from Colonial Williamsburg’s admissions, products and hospitality operations sustains the Foundation’s core educational mission together with critical, direct donor support.

For the first time this year, Colonial Williamsburg is participating with Facebook in PayPal’s #GivingTuesday match. Starting at 8 a.m. Eastern time Nov. 27, the online payment company will match online donations to participating organizations up to a total of \$7 million.
