Blacksmith and Public Armoury Red-hot iron from the fires of their forges is transformed into tools, hardware, and weapons. (Open Thu.–Mon.)

Brickyard Discover the process of making bricks. (Open Tue.–Sat.)

Cabinetmaker The finest furniture of the age is crafted here. (Open Sun.–Fri.)

Prentis Field See crops common to Virginia plantations.

Printing Office Discover how news was spread. (Open Sun.–Thu.)

Public Leather Works Leather and heavy textiles are made into a variety of products. (Open Sun.–Thu.)

Tin Shop See our “tin men” snip, shape, and bend this flexible material into useful objects. (Open Tue.–Sat.)

Colonial Garden Vegetables, heirloom roses, and herbs.

Cooper Staves and hoops are made into a variety of wooden containers. (Open Tue.–Sat.)

Geddy Foundry Bronze, brass, silver, and pewter crafted into 18th-century style items. (Open Fri.–Tue.)

Joinery Wood is made into pieces of a future building. (Open Fri.–Wed.)

Palace Kitchen Food is prepared for the royal governor’s family. (Open Wed.–Sat.)

Shoemaker Watch them make footwear. (Open Wed.–Sun.)

Tailor Fabrics and garments that clothed colonial Americans. (Open Sun.–Thu.)

Weaver Flax, cotton, and wool are converted from tangled masses into precise fabrics. (Open Thu.–Tue.)

Wheelwright Construct and repair historical vehicles. (Open Sun.–Thu.)

Wigmaker Wigmakers fashion “perukes” of quality and distinction. (Open Mon.–Wed., Fri., & Sun.)

Christiana Campbell’s Tavern George Washington’s favorite for seafood. (Tue.–Sat., 5–close)

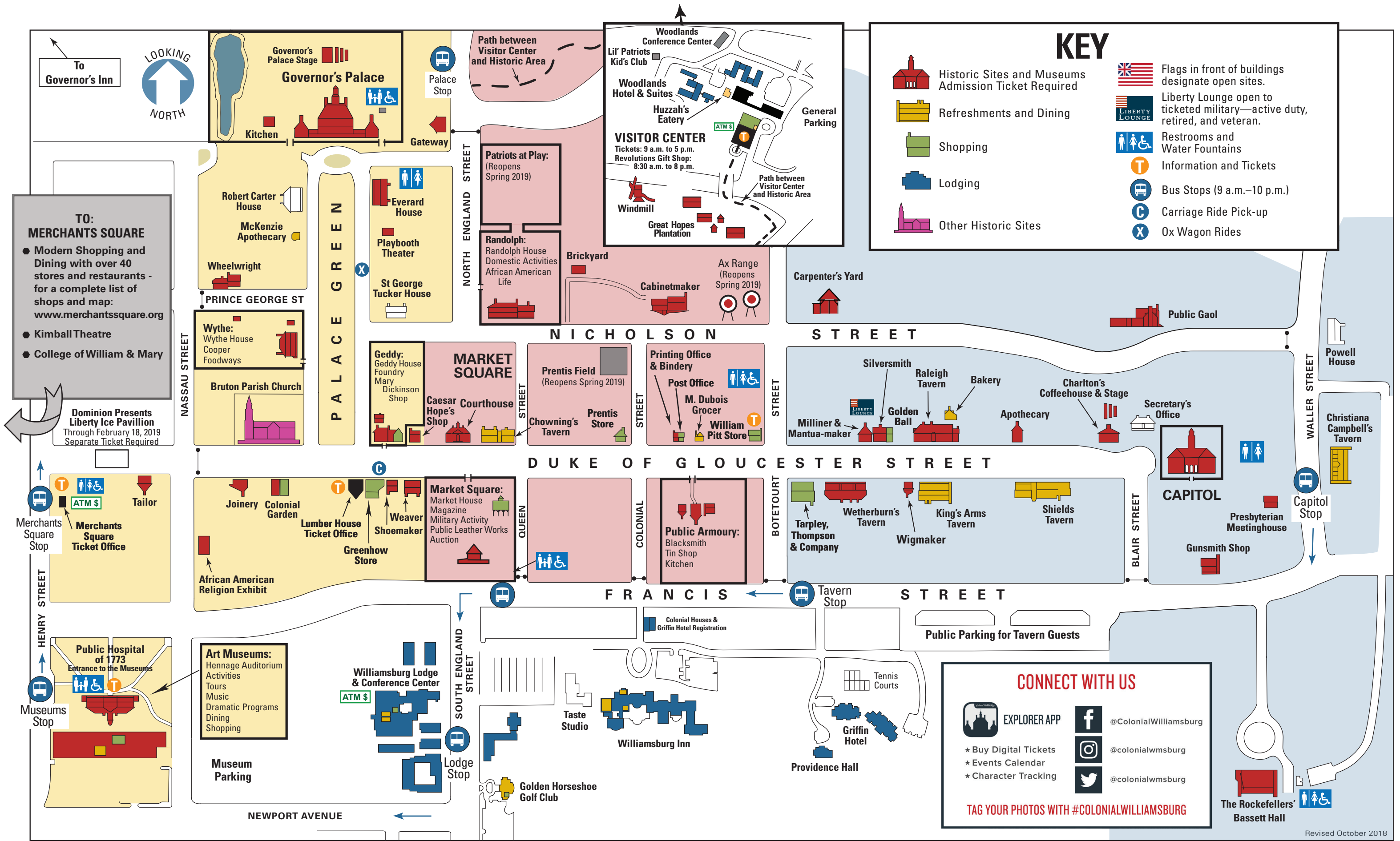
